### CLOTHING AND ACCESSORIES

- Sewing Kit
- Fashion tape
- Clear varnish (stops ladders spreading further in tights)
- White chalk (for stains)
- Crochet hook (for those tiny buttons)
- Spare flat shoes/flip flops
- Spare earrings/earring backs
- Insoles/gel pads

### FOR THE GROOM

- Shoe polish
- Spare shoe laces
- Lint roller
- Hair gel
- Comb
- Spare cufflinks

### MISCELLANEOUS

- Straws (for drinking pre-ceremony fizz without smudging your lipstick)
- Small amount of cash
- Dental floss
- Superglue (this can be used to fix shoes/handbags/jewellery/head pieces etc)

### OTHER TIPS

- Don't wait until the night before your wedding to put this together, try and do it as early as possible. The week before your wedding will be a whirlwind so it's best to do it while you're feeling relatively calm.
- Ask a friend, or one of your bridesmaids, to put this together and be in charge of it on the day.
- Try asking friends and relatives who are married what they think you might need.
- Buy travel-sized products, most supermarkets have them.
